Chairman Haman called the meeting to order. Commissioners Bryan Bruner, Larry Haman, Armann Anderson, David Medalen and Brady Nelson were in attendance.

A motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Nelson to approve the liquor license for Star City Golf Club in Velva. Motion carried unanimously.
