OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE MCHENRY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

December 7, 2021

9:00 AM

Chairman Bruner called the meeting to order. Commissioners Bryan Bruner, Larry Haman, Armann Anderson, David Medalen and Brady Nelson were in attendance.

A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Haman to approve the November 2nd, 16th and 24th minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Tina Powell, Josh Frey, Trey Skager, Judge Hurly, Scott Johnson and Doug Larson met with the board to discuss possible upgrades to the jury room and courtroom. The proposal was presented in two phases, the first to upgrade the jury room and the second to make changes in the courtroom. They would concentrate on the first phase, which is to remove two walls that would eliminate the States Attorney/Emergency Management office. They asked the board to authorize \$5,000 to allow JLG Architects to work on plans and an estimate on the costs for this phase of the project in order to apply for a grant through the Court Facilities Improvement Fund. The architect will be open to other ideas and it was stated the project will only be pursued if grant funds are secured. A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Haman to allocate \$5,000 for the architectural fees. Motion carried unanimously.

For the purpose of reorganizing the board, Chairman Bruner relinquished his chair to the Auditor. The auditor called for nominations for Chair. Bruner nominated Larry Haman. No other nominations were made. A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Anderson that nominations cease and a unanimous ballot be cast for Haman. Motion carried unanimously. The auditor called for nominations for Vice Chair. Medalen nominated Brady Nelson. No other nominations were made. A motion was made by Haman that nominations cease and a unanimous ballot be cast for Nelson. No other nominations were made. A motion was made by Bruner and seconded by Haman that nominations cease and a unanimous ballot be cast for Nelson. Motion carried unanimously. The auditor turned the meeting over to Chairman Haman.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Bruner to change the cutoff dates for the blademen. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Bruner and seconded by Medalen to issue the proper deed to Cheap Home Finders, Inc. for the sale of county land described as Lot 8 Blk 1 Orig Anamoose, Lots 11-12 Blk 1 Orig Anamoose, Lot 15 Blk 5 Orig Anamoose, Lots 4-6 Blk 3 Muellers Add Anamoose, and to cancel any remaining taxes. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Haman to approve abatement 1405. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Bruner and seconded by Anderson to reissue lost instrument #82112. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Bruner to adopt a capital asset policy, a fraud prevention and investigation policy, and a fund balance policy in accordance with GASB Statement No. 54. Motion carried unanimously.

Jason Mayfield met with the board to discuss future bridge funding. A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Nelson to accept the bid from Asphalt Technologies Corporation in the amount of \$1,259,733.60 for the micro mill and microsurfacing project known as SC-CVD-2500(021). Motion carried unanimously.

The board recessed for lunch.

Jason Mayfield and Representative Paul Thomas met with the board to discuss bridge needs and possible funding.

Community Service Coordinator, Tony Coffman stopped by to introduce himself.

Helen Lehmann met with the board to discuss when to advertise for her position, as she will be retiring in May.

A consent motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Bruner to approve the following: Treasurer's Miscellaneous Receipts #46093-46161; the monthly payroll in the amount of \$131,072.20 paid by warrant checks #26659-26709; Clerk of Court Nov County fees \$828.70, State fees \$13,976.36; Clerk of Court Dec County fees \$485.00, State fees \$8,513.00, ND Dept of Trust Lands \$2,237.00, City of Velva \$20.00; County Recorder November recording fees of \$3,986.00 and misc fees of \$558.30; Sheriff November statement of fees \$660.00, Sheriff mileage \$580.00, Deputy reports for Oct.
