OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE MCHENRY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

September 7, 2021

9:00 AM

Chairman Bruner called the meeting to order. Commissioners Bryan Bruner, David Medalen, Larry Haman, Armann Anderson and Brady Nelson were present. Lisa Wittstruck also was in attendance.

A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Anderson to approve the August 3rd minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Brian Kraft with RDO Equipment briefly met with the board regarding a Cooperative Purchasing agreement.

Keith Cederstrom, representing the Velva Area History Museum, provided a mission statement for the museum and requested county funding. According to NDCC 11-11-53, county museums requesting to utilize county funds are required to be approved as a nonprofit corporation, and to be affiliated with and has its articles of incorporation and bylaws approved by the state historical society and the attorney general. Upon receipt of those documents, the board will take their request into consideration.

Correspondence was received from Towner City regarding a tree that needs to be removed. The county will look into hiring a contractor.

A motion was made by Haman and seconded by Anderson to approve floodplain permit #26 for Enbridge to repair a pipe. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Haman to approve Phase I of the dome restoration project to repair and patch the holes to eliminate water penetration. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Haman to accept the changes to the personnel policy as recommended by NDACo. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Haman left the meeting.

Due to the scheduling of the NDACo convention during the October meeting date, a motion was made by Bruner and seconded by Anderson to move the October meeting from October 5th to October 7th. Motion carried unanimously.

Kyle Patterson, the Vision Zero Regional Coordinator, met with the board to introduce himself and provide information on the Vision Zero program.

Commissioner Haman joined the meeting. Lisa Wittstruck left the meeting.

The board recessed for lunch.

Kent Indvik and Jason Mayfield met with the board to discuss a new option for bridge 25-113.02 located NW of Upham. The state will possibly have funding for bridge replacement projects. In reviewing the costs to repair or replace, it was determined the replacement would be more feasible. A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Haman to pursue replacement of this bridge. Motion carried unanimously. A new option to repair the Oium Bridge was also discussed.

Commissioner Anderson introduced the following final resolution and Commissioner Bruner moved its adoption to combine the offices of McHenry County Auditor and McHenry County Treasurer:

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners adopted a preliminary resolution and approved a plan for combining the offices of McHenry County Auditor and McHenry County Treasurer as provided by Chapter 11-10.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, and

WHEREAS, the preliminary resolution and proposed plan were published in the Mouse River Journal twice within the thirty-day period immediately following the adoption of the preliminary resolution, and

WHEREAS, the preliminary resolution and proposed plan were the subject of a public hearing held during the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of County Commissioners on Tuesday, June 1, 2021, in order to encourage public discussion of the purpose, conclusions, and recommendations of the plan, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is satisfied adoption of the proposed plan will improve the effectiveness and efficiency of county government and its responsiveness and accountability to local citizens, without diminishing the general responsibility of county government to perform any function or provide and service that is required by law to be performed or provided by county government,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the terms of the proposed plan approved May 4, 2021 be affirmed and finalized, so that effective upon retirement or end of term, whichever comes first, the offices of McHenry County Auditor and McHenry County Treasurer are and shall be combined, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the approved plan shall be filed both with the District Court in McHenry County and with the McHenry County Auditor.

Commissioners Anderson, Bruner and Medalen voting aye. Commissioners Haman and Nelson voting nay. Resolution passed.
