August 2, 2022

Chairman Haman called the meeting to order. Commissioners Bryan Bruner (via phone), Larry Haman, Armann Anderson, David Medalen and Brady Nelson were present. Others attending were Shawn Kramer and Johnna Torr.

A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Anderson to approve the July 5th minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Mark Lyman with the Minot Area Chamber EDC met with the board regarding a \$1.83 million grant opportunity through state ARPA funds for a regional workforce impact project, and have asked the county for a letter of support. Mark explained the areas that would be targeted for potential funding would be daycare infrastructure, CDL simulator training, mobile meat labs program, training in healthcare-specifically dental hygienists, and homeless shelters/housing for families.

Brad Murphy with RDO met with the board and introduced Chad Johnson as the new sales representative for our county.

Duane Drader joined the meeting.

Brad explained the purchasing program through the State of Minnesota.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Medalen to send a resolution of support for the Minot Area Chamber EDC. Motion carried unanimously.

Ryan Ackerman and Sabrina Herrmann with Ackerman-Estvold Engineering met with the board to provide an update on the Souris Basin flood management project. He noted the Velva bridge is scheduled for 2023.

Jason Mayfield with Wold Engineering met with the board and mentioned the Drake microsurfacing project should be done by the end of the week and they will move to the Granville/Deering area.

A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Nelson to sign the Civil Rights Certification for the Housing Board. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Anderson to approve the raffle permit for the Velva Wildlife Club. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Medalen to approve abatement #1412. Motion carried unanimously.

Contract police agreements were received from Towner City and Velva City.

The board recessed for lunch.

Duane Drader and Johnna Torr joined the meeting.

A motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Anderson to install a 36" X 40' culvert between sections 20/27 in Meadow Township. Motion carried unanimously.

The board spoke to Kristi Suchor, NDIRF agent regarding the new optional insurance coverage.

Deputy David Dewanz, Chief Deputy Dustin Welstad and States Attorney Josh Frey met with the board regarding their decision to purchase ten Glock 17 handguns for the Sheriff's Department officers. In the past, it was the department's policy that weapons used for duty purposes were supplied by the officer so as to give the officers the choice of weapon that fits their hand. According to the State Attorney, the Sheriff's Department will need to change their policy prior to issuing the new handguns to the officers. The guns will be purchased with asset forfeiture funds.

States Attorney Josh Frey explained his department budget request.

Commissioner Bruner left the meeting.

The board reviewed the 2023 budget. A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Anderson to approve the 2023 preliminary budget. Motion carried unanimously.

A consent motion was made by Medalen and seconded by Nelson to approve the following: Treasurer's Miscellaneous Receipts #46697-46777; the monthly payroll in the amount of \$147,940.03 paid by warrant checks #27064-27109. Clerk of Court July County fees \$611.88, State fees \$15,019.72; County Recorder July recording fees of \$4,629.00 and misc fees of \$284.50; Sheriff July statement of fees \$495.00, Sheriff mileage \$623.89, Deputy reports for June/July.

The board continued to audit bills until completed. A motion was made by Anderson and seconded by Medalen that the following bills be approved and the proper checks be issued thereof:
