Capital Power submitted a letter they would like the board to sign which indicates they have acquired all the necessary permits. A motion was made by Roger and seconded by Nancy to recommend the county commissioners sign the letter. Motion carried unanimously.

Steve Haskins provided the setback measurements on his application.

A motion was made by Darrell and seconded by Roger to approve the Powell and Haskins applications, pending receipt of a septic permit from First District Health. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Bill and seconded by Lyle to approve the Anderson application. Motion carried unanimously.

First District Health contacted the county and stated Ryan Latendresse does not have a septic permit through them, and the system they had previously installed is not in compliance. A motion was made by Bill and seconded by Lyle to send Ryan a certified letter, informing him he is out of compliance with First District Health and his application will not be acted on.
